Fri 17th & Sat 18th January

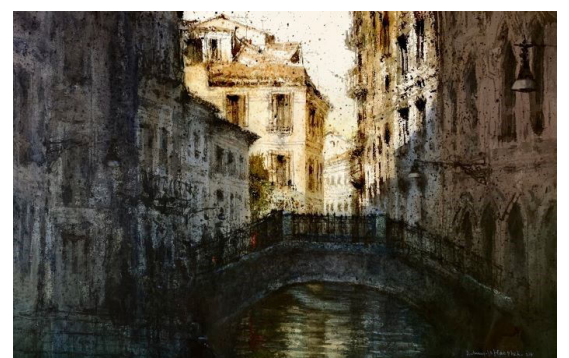
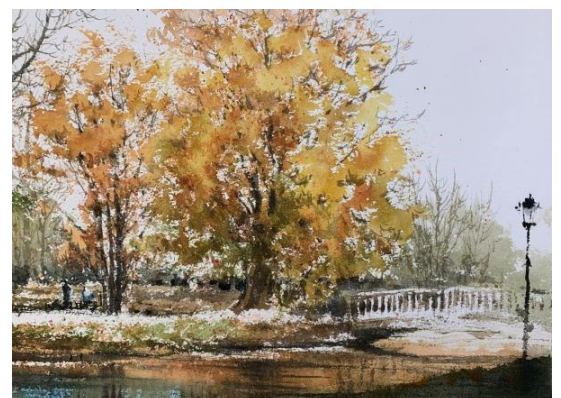
9.30am - 4pm each day Cost : \$275 (plus materials)

Cost: \$50 (\$30 fee + \$20 materials)

This introduction to Mosaic class has a maximum of 6 students suitable for school aged children . In this class you will make two drink coasters to take home, using pre cut pieces of different shapes & colours.

Cost: \$130 + materials

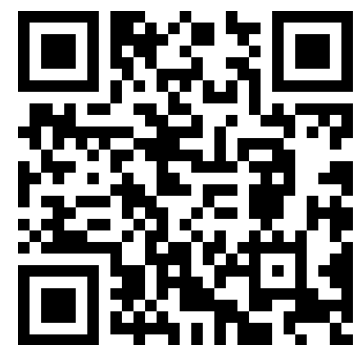
Learn to create a portrait in pastel, using the techniques & skills from the Old Masters under the expert guidance of Phillip Wills.

'Botanical Pears' - with Miffy Gilbert

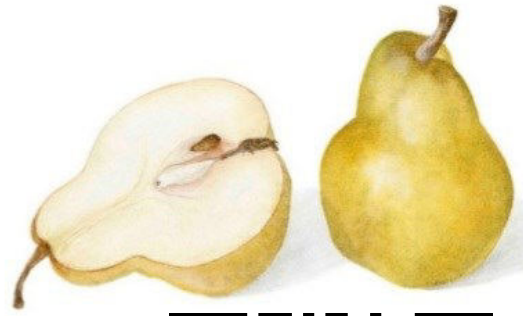
Sat 18th & Sun 19th January

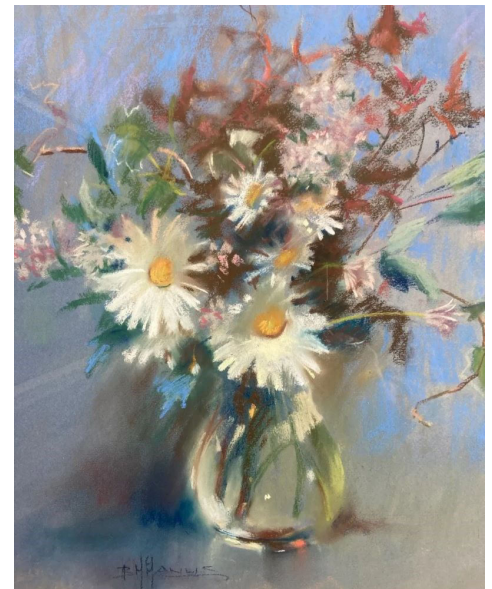
An opportunity to learn from an Award winning master pastelist. This 1 Day class will suit both experienced and beginners to build a pastel painting working from life.
